After the defibrillator was installed in the phone box, training was held in February and March last year. This was provided by members of the East Midlands' 'First Responder Group', and the sessions were extremely well received by attendees (20+ across the two dates).

The session covers the techniques of 'CPR' or Call, Push, Rescue, processes and practical actions which are performed if a possible or actual cardiac arrest has occurred. It includes the use of training defibrillator devices which the trainers will bring.
